On today`s date, 07/02/2021 I was dispatched to a reported suicide at the Perico Preserve located at 11700 Manatee Ave W. Upon my arrival I located a white male later identified as Mr. Scott St Blanc who appeared to have hung himself. There was no signs of trauma and it does not appear to be suspicious. Mr. St Blanc tied a teal and white rope around his neck to commit the act. The rope was secured to a roof beam to a pavilion where he was located. The subject was wearing a blue shirt and blue shorts. EMS pronounced him deceased at 0745 hours. Once the information was gathered, BPD detectives/CSI responded along with the Medical Examiners office. The medical examiners form was completed and handed over to them. Mr. St Blanc was removed from the scene and the detectives will handle the next of kin notification as they are already working a case with Mr. St Blanc. For further information see other involved officers supplements. Ofc. Moore spoke to the caller who contacted 911 and added her to his supplement.

On June 2nd, 2021, I responded to the incident location in reference to a suicide attempt. I responded in priority mode with my lights and sirens activated. While enroute, Ofc. Gause advised that the subject was deceased and had been there awhile. I deactivated my lights and sirens and continued to the location. Upon arrival, I observed an older white male hanging from a green rope. The rope was attached to a support of the the bungalo sitting area. I searched the area for a suicide note with negative results. I maintained a crime scene log and submitted it to records. I had no further involvement in this case. My body camera was activated.

On 07-02-2021, I responded to the scene of a suicide. Upon arrival Det. Perez, Ofc. Moore, and Ofc. Gause were on scene. The subject in question was identified by his ID as Mr. Scott St Blanc. After viewing the subject on scene, it was confirmed that it was indeed Mr. St Blanc due to working a case with him on 07-01-2021.

The scene is a County Park that is secluded from the roadway. Mr. St Blanc was located at the first gazebo from the roadway. The gazebo is covered with a single picnic table underneath it. The ground in this area is covered with loose shell.

Mr. St Blanc used a rope, tied one end to the gazebo rafter and the other to his neck. Mr. St Blanc then just kneeled down, cutting his circulation off, where he committed suicide. It should be noted that Mr. St Blanc could have stood up at anytime during this act, but choose not to. There were no other injuries or anything suspicious found on scene.

Mr. St Blanc was checked by BFD and EMS on scene, where he was pronounced deceased. Due to this Mr. St Blanc was not taken down right away. CSI responded to the scene where they photographed the scene and Mr. St Blanc. Once photos were obtained, Mr. St Blanc was untied and assisted to the ground. At this time the ME Body Removal arrived on scene and secured Mr. St Blanc. They removed Mr. St Blanc and the rope from the scene.

There are no security cameras on scene and no witnesses to the incident. I took no further action at this time. See Det. Perez`s supplement for further in this case.

On July 2nd, 2021, I responded to a suicide at Perico Preserve. I immediately recognized the decedent as Mr. Scott St. Blanc, who I met yesterday during a search warrant. I checked Mr. St. Blancs` person for any notes or anything of evidentiary value but was unable to locate any. Mr. St. Blanc had suspended himself from wooden pavilion utilizing rope. I observed ligature mark below the current position of the rope around his neck. It appears as if the rope tightened and moved from its initial position after some time.

I responded to Mr. St. Blancs` residence and checked for any notes regarding his suicide to no avail. His vehicle was also in the parking lot to his residence and was also checked for anything of evidentiary value. I responded to the leasing office where Mr. St. Blanc lives and spoke with management regarding an emergency contact. I was provided with the name [REDACTED], who I met with later on. [REDACTED] provided me with the name of some of Mr. St. Blancs` family members.

I found Mr. St. Blancs` [REDACTED], [REDACTED] advised that [REDACTED] are Mr. St. Blancs` next of kin. I provided her with pertinent information along with the number the medicals examiners office.

The medical examiners office has been advised that NOK was notified and contact information was provided to them as well.
